• WAGE AND HOUR ACT (HOURS AND OVERTIME)

STATUTORY CITATION: N.C. Gen. Stat. §§ 95-25.1 – 95-25.25

GENERAL SUMMARY: In addition to establishing a minimum wage and other employment standards, the Wage and Hour Act generally requires subject employers to pay each covered employee at a rate not less than $1^1/2$ times the employee's regular rate of pay for every hour of employment in excess of 40 hours in any workweek.

PROVISIONS APPLICABLE TO AGRICULTURE: The overtime provision in the Wage and Hour Act *does not apply* to anyone employed in agriculture.
